8:15 AM – Meet at 819 N. Ross Street Parking. Line up cars as they arrive in the parking lot pointing/facing west.

8:25 AM – Leave the parking lot. Drive to Hall of Administration. See map of route below.

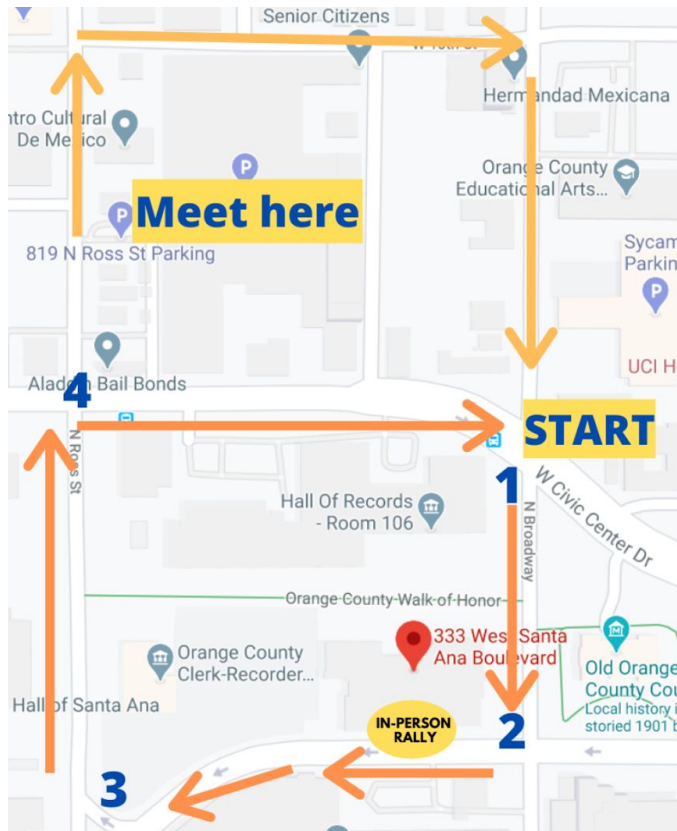
Directions

1. Turn RIGHT. Drive north on N. ROSS STREET.
2. Turn RIGHT on W. 10th STREET.
 - a. Continue on W. 10th Street.
3. Turn RIGHT on N. BROADWAY.
 - a. Continue on N. Broadway.
4. Turn RIGHT on W. SANTA ANA BOULEVARD.
 - a. Continue on W. Santa Ana Boulevard.
5. Turn RIGHT on N. ROSS STREET.
 - a. Continue on N. Ross Street.
6. Turn RIGHT on W. CIVIC CENTER DRIVE.

- a. Continue on W. Civic Center Drive.
7. Turn RIGHT on N. BROADWAY.
8. REPEAT the route making as much noise as possible until 9:00 AM.

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS (LEGAL) SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. During the action itself, post photos and videos with #DefundOCSD #StopThisMusick and #InvestInPeopleNotJails hashtags and tag participating groups. See social media account information below.
2. Please do not talk to law enforcement. We will have NLG legal support on site.
3. If you are pulled over or approached by police, alert the group in-person or over the call if you are participating in the car rally.

4. If you are participating in the car rally, make sure you have a licensed driver, and current registration and proof of insurance with you.
5. If you are participating in the car rally, please comply with all traffic laws, including yielding to pedestrians, and red lights, (even if it separates cars from the group).
6. If you are participating in the car rally, pay close attention to what is in front of you. Please avoid accidents by maintaining enough distance between you and the car in front of you so as to have time to break.
7. If you are participating in the car rally, keep your hazard lights on, so people know who is part of the action.
8. If you are participating in the car rally, drive at a steady speed and stay in line.
